Safety Talk

Have you ever seen a near-miss? Have you ever been involved in a near-miss? What is the difference between a near-miss and an accident? Inches or seconds could be the difference. Usually near-misses lead to accidents that could have been prevented.

Very few accidents happen due to a single cause and very few accidents occur without some warning. If you have witnessed or been involved in a near-miss you have seen the signs of something being wrong.

1. Think of near-miss accidents as more important than an accident because they can prevent an accident.
2. Don't laugh off near misses, next time they might not be.
3. Report all near-misses
